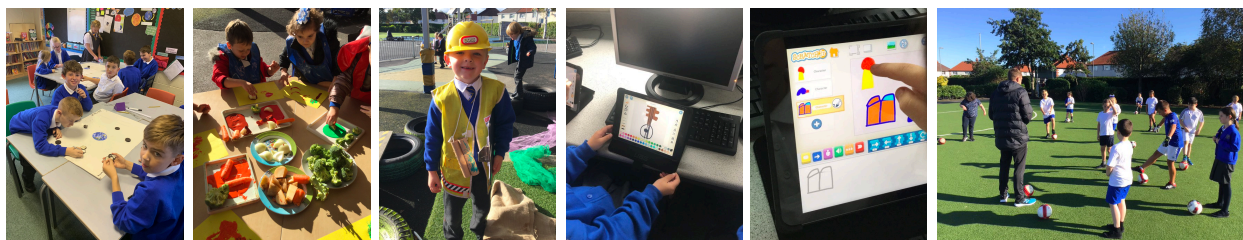
Celebrating International Coffee Day at Costa Coffee

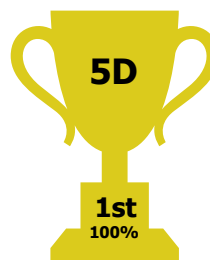
