DAILY LITERACY ACTIVITIES

Literacy Challenge

DAILY MATHS ACTIVITIES

Maths Capacity Challenge

Today we are going to continue to compare the capacity of containers using our key vocabulary. Choose one container and a large spoon/ small cup, independently count out how many spoonfuls of water you will need to make the container empty, half full and full. Once you have counted them, find the number on your number line and record your results in a table [like this](#). Then choose a second container, look at its size and shape. You are now going to use your prediction skills to predict if this container will take more or less spoonfuls to make it full.
