DAILY MATHS ACTIVITIES

Counting jumps!

Can you jump like Jack jumping off the beanstalk? Can you count a total of up to 5 big jumps? Can you jump a total of up to 10 big jumps?

Ask your adult to make number cards up to 5/10. Place the number cards 'face downwards' on the floor. Next, pick up a number card and jump the amount of jumps to match the number shown on the card.

Challenge

Can you place the number cards in order from 1 to 5? Can you try ordering from 1 to 10? Can you record/make marks to represent any of the numerals?



THE WIDER CURRICULUM

Enjoy making scrambled egg with your adult by following the recipe below. Remember to wash your hand first. Sing the 'Happy Birthday song'!

You will need:

2 eggs
Butter
Pan
spoon
Milk



Method: First, grease a pan with butter.

Next, crack an egg into the pan.

Finally, add a splash of milk to your egg and mix until the egg and milk join together and become fluffy. Wait to cool, then enjoy on top of toast!
