DAILY LITERACY ACTIVITIES

Can you create a missing poster to help find the gingerbread men! Pick your favourite gingerbread man from the video for your poster. Think about what information your poster will need to include. It will need to inform people he is lost! It will need to include adjectives to describe the gingerbread man. You might want to include a drawing of the gingerbread man!

Have a go at writing a simple sentence for your poster e.g. He is lost.
He is big and fast.

Don't forget to say your sentence orally first! You might want to build your sentence on word cards to help you write it like we do in class.
