Count things that are NOT objects (up to 5/10)

Your adult holds up a number card (randomly) and you carry out actions to match the number shown to you. i.e. number 2, you jump 2 times etc.



Count 5 hops

Count 2 yawns

Count 4 stretches

Count 6 claps

Count 8 sit downs/stand ups

Count 1 statue

Count 7 arm folds

Count 9 smiles

Count 10 stand on one legs

Exploring floating and sinking

First, with help from your adult, collect objects from around your home then fill a washing up bowl/the bath with warm water.

Place an object into the water, one at a time and see what happens.

What can you see? Why do you think this is happening?

Talk about the words '**floating**' and '**sinking**.' Learn that '**sinking**' is when an object goes/sinks to the bottom of the bowl/bath and '**floating**' is when an object floats on the top of the water.

Can you make a boat that will float on water?

Look at how the colours change when they are mixed together.

Make orange- mix red and yellow.

Make purple- mix red and blue

Make green- mix blue and yellow
