## DAILY MATHS ACTIVITIES

Count things that are NOT objects (up to 5/10)

Your adult holds up a number card (randomly) and you carry out actions to match the number shown to you. i.e. number 2, you jump 2 times etc.



Count 5 turns

Count 2 blinks

Count 4 star jumps

Count 6 taps on the head

Count 8 'lying downs'

Count 1 kick

Count 7 bunny jumps

Count 9 snarls

Count 10 toe taps

Challenge

7 hops and 2 more makes... hops altogether

## THE WIDER CURRICULUM



There are special foods from different countries. Pizza comes from a country called Italy. Enjoy making pizza with your adult. You can buy pizza bases from the supermarket or even use flat bread or a wrap.

First, spread the tomato paste on to the pizza base.

Next, sprinkle your cheese on top.

Then, put your choice of topping on to your cheese. i.e. tomatoes, ham, peppers, sausage etc. Finally, place your pizza either under the grill or in the oven to cook.

Challenge

Look at how the pizza changes after it has been cooked? What do you notice? Why was it cooked first?
