Challenge

Talk with your adult about what a rectangle shape looks like i.e. A rectangle has four straight sides and 4 vertices/corners. Are all the sides the same length? What do you notice about the sides of a rectangle? Can a rectangle roll? What is the difference between a square and a rectangle?

WOW WORD- THE CORRECT MATHEMATICAL WORD FOR CORNER IS VERTICE.

(Pronounced- Vert-is -ee)
