School Photographs

Wearing the Correct Uniform on PE Day

I want to remind parents/carers that the children must come into school in their PE kits on their designated PE day. The children need to wear a white polo shirt or white t-shirt, their school jumper or cardigan and tracksuit bottoms or leggings with trainers. The tracksuit bottoms or leggings need to be navy or black. The children must also bring a waterproof coat/jacket as the vast majority of PE lessons will now take place outside. It is important that your child wears the correct items and not football kits/full tracksuits/crop-tops etc. Thank you for your support with this. We will be monitoring this after the half-term.

30 Hour Funded Nursery Places

Our nursery provision is changing and I am absolutely delighted to announce that, from September 2021, we are able to offer our parents/carers fully funded, 30-hour a week nursery places, to those who are entitled. This 30-hour provision is for:

- For working families in England.
- With 3 and/or 4 year-old children.
- ▶ 30 hours of free childcare or early education for 38 weeks.
- A total of **1,140 hours per year**, that you can use flexibly with one or more childcare provider.

Do not worry if you are not eligible, as all families with a 3 and 4 year old child will still be eligible for the universal offer of free early education of up to 15 hours a week term time. Morning or afternoon sessions will be available as per usual. The morning sessions will take place between 8:30am until 11:30am. The afternoon sessions will be held between 12:00pm until 3:00pm.
