Dear parents/carers,

I hope that this email reaches you safe and well. I write to you today to keep you up to date with a few 'bits and bobs' as we approach the end of the academic year. The weeks are flying by and it'll be the end of term before we know it - as a result, I thought I'd just highlight a few important dates and some key messages so that we are all on the same page.

Finish Date and Time

The children are due to finish for the Summer holidays on Friday 16th July at 1:30pm. Our morning nursery children will finish on the same day but at 11:30am. There will be no afternoon nursery on Friday 16th July. They will finish the day before.

A Change to an INSET Day Scheduled for Next Year

Unfortunately, the INSET day scheduled for Friday 22nd October 2021 has been moved to Friday 24th September 2021. This is because the company we are using for some vital staff training can only commit to Friday 24th September. Just to clarify, the INSET day on Friday 22nd October 2021 has been moved to Friday 24th September 2021 - there will be no INSET day on Friday 22nd October 2021.

End of Year Reports

That is because the following week, we have planned to hold telephone consultations for any parents/carers who would like to speak to their child's class teacher to discuss the report.
