

Year 1 Understanding Materials in Design Technology

Year 1 have been learning about materials in Design Technology. They have been exploring our key question: 'Can you build a house from bread?' The children looked at properties of bread and predicted how they would change when it has been toasted. After that, they then considered which would be the most suitable building material. The children decided to use toast to construct a house and agreed icing sugar would be the best bonding material. Design ideas were completed and they annotated them showing their critical thinking. This week, it was time to start building. With a pile of toast at the ready and a pot full of icing sugar, the children worked as a team to construct a house!

Art and Design Enrichment Trip - the Van Gogh Experience!

Earlier this week, Year 6 pupils immersed themselves into the spectacular 'Beyond Van Gogh Experience' where they were absorbed into the sensory, mindful and appreciative world of art. Pupils were whisked off to the Exhibition Centre Liverpool on King's Dock with Mrs Doyle (our Art Lead) and Mrs Michaela (our Art Link Governor) to view over 300 masterpieces, including 'The Starry Night', 'Sunflowers' and 'Café Terrace at Night.'
