

We work closely with schools, health services, and local authorities to ensure that children and young people with disabilities get the support they need and if not, work with the services to improve what is on offer for families within the local area. They offer coffee and training sessions so that, parents can share their experiences, get advice, and find resources to help them care for their children and young people. LivPac want to empower parents and carers to speak up for their children and young people and navigate the systems involved in getting support.
