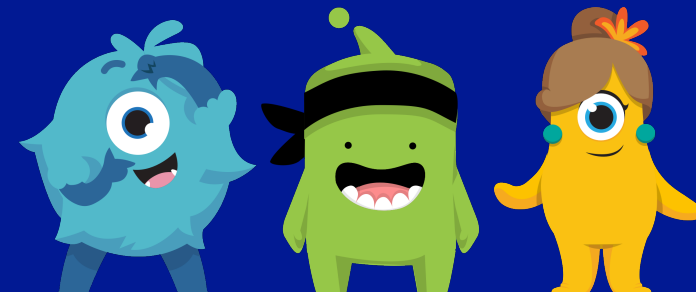

Continuous provision refers to the consistent learning areas (e.g., mark-making, role-play, construction, small world, outdoors) that children can access all the time to support learning through play. During continuous provision, children learn through everyday play in thoughtfully set-up environments where opportunities are woven into all areas of learning. It's: child-led, purposeful, play-based, developmentally appropriate, consistent and secure and supported by skilled adults. Adults play a key role during continuous provision. Children learn independently and through skilled adult interactions: modelling, scaffolding and extending ideas during play, creating and maintaining rich and inclusive environments, adding enhancements linked to assessment and supporting independence and autonomy.
